Failure to obtain a Tender document or non-attendance at the site inspection will result in the immediate disqualification of your tender. Tenderers are required to meet at uThukela District Municipality, 36 Lyell Street.

Sealed tenders endorsed with the **Tender no. and Discription of the Tender** must be deposited in the tender box of the uThukela District Municipality, 36 Lyell Street, Ladysmith before **12h00 on Wednesday 11 March 2020**, after which tender will be open in public.

It will be the tenderer's responsibility to check the document on receipt for completeness and to notify the employer of any discrepancies or omissions. It is the tenderer's responsibility to provide all the data and information requested completely and in the form required, failure to do so may be regarded by the employer as a non-responsive tender.


UThukela District Municipality will strive to achieve targeted procurement in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Regulation 2017 in a manner that only tenderers who are BBEE LEVEL 1 are targeted for this tender.

A minimum of 15% of the value of the contract must be contracted to:

- An EME or QSE
- EME or QSE which is at least 51% black owned,
- EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black youth (from the ages 14 to 35),
- EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people who are women,
- EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people with disabilities,
- EME or QSE which is 51% owned by black people living in rural or underdeveloped areas or townships,
- A co-operative which is at least 51% owned by black people,
- EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people who are military veterans; or
