27/2024-CON	<p>Interested contractors with appropriate experience are invited to submit tenders for the completion of the construction of Wembezi Water Conservation and Demand Management Phase 1A Reticulation.</p> <p>The works consists of the construction of 1.8 km of 450mm HDPE gravity pipelines; 0.3 km of HDPE reticulation network with diameters from 75mm to 160mm; commissioning of existing reticulation network, ERF connections and household plumbing, air, scour and isolating valve chambers; river/donga crossings; ERF connections, repair of existing household plumbing, road crossings including Horizontal Directional Drilling.</p>	6 CE or Higher

Tender documents will be available at the Site Briefing Meeting subject to payment being made prior to the meeting and Proof of Payment provided at the meeting. Payment can be made via EFT or at the offices of the uThukela District Municipality, 36 Lyell Street, Ladysmith, at a non-refundable cost of **R500.00** per document. Documents will only be available at the site inspection if proof of payment has been submitted to the Engineer to reserve the document for the Tenderer **before 12h00 on Friday 04 October 2024**. No documents will be available at the Briefing meeting for Tenderers who have not reserved the document.

Tenderers should have a CIDB Contractor Grading as specified in the table above, or higher. Tenderer must score a minimum of 70 points for Functionality for the tender to be considered further.

A **Compulsory** Site Inspection will be held on **Thursday 10 October 2024 at 11h00**. Failure to purchase a Tender Document or non-attendance at the site inspection will result in immediate disqualification of your tender. Tenderers are required to meet at the Wembezi Site Camp / Taxi Rank. Directions are as follows:

- From the N3 highway take existing ramp 175 signposted "Wembezi, Giants Castle, Estcourt"
- Travel along Road P29 towards Giants Castle for about 5 km
- As you enter the town of Wembezi at the robots you turn left and the site camp/taxi rank is directly on your left (29° 02' 38.11"S ; 29° 47' 19.38"E).
